The boys' soccer squad hosted Des Moines East at Island Park last night. Here are the highlights from each game:

- In the opening game the freshmen squad had a tough time with DSM East's huge, talented squad. Despite being under pressure for a considerable part of the game the Tigers never gave up, and did show a great deal of progress towards the end. Their inexperience early in the game contributed to a quick, two goal deficit. However, they fought back well and actually led 3-2 at one point. Eventually they succumbed to their guests and lost 3-4, but they did give a very good account of themselves. Iain Newman scored the first goal just before halftime when he stripped the ball from an opponent and quickly drove it beyond the goalkeeper and into the top left hand corner of the net. Braidon Lee scored the equalizer just after half time when he picked up a poor clearance from the goalkeeper, quickly raced in on goal and slipped the ball into the net. Isaac Higgins then scored a third goal when he intercepted a poor pass, dribbled round two opponents and crashed a powerful shot into the right hand corner of the goal. Despite this loss the freshmen squad does show plenty of promise.
- In the JV game the Tigers again got off to a slow start and were three goals down at halftime. However, they rallied in the second half and created a number of decent goal scoring opportunities before losing 1-3. Lucas O'Conner scored the lone Tiger goal mid way through the second half when he dispossessed an opponent, rounded another defender and then fired a powerful shot beyond the goalkeeper and into the back of the net.
