The boys' soccer squad had a tough and entertaining scrimmage with the very experienced Norwalk squad last night. The next games are against Des Moines East, at Island Park **tomorrow**. Here are the highlights from last night's games:

- The freshmen surprised their more experienced opponents by scoring two hard earned, second half goals, against the wind, to win comfortably 2-0. Five minutes into the second half, Tyler Bottorff scored the opening goal when he ran on to a finely weighted pass from Nathan Wedemeyer, rounded an opposing defender and coolly stroked the ball into the left hand corner of the net. Ten minutes later Devin Moody sealed a fine win when he controlled a through pass from Sam Bardwell before expertly lobbing the ball over the advancing goalkeeper and into the empty net. Charles Craigmile and Conner Chappell combined for the shut out in goal.
- The promising JV squad played well against a much bigger and more physical Norwalk squad, but eventually lost 0-2.
- The varsity drew 0-0 with the third placed team in last year's state tournament. In doing so, they showed some definite promise and the defense and the midfield group in particular looked very good at times. Drew Gordon earned the shutout in the Tigers' goal.

ADM's varsity jazz choir, Amp, performed at state jazz choir championships yesterday at West Des Moines Valley and received 3rd place- the best in school history. Good job to everyone involved in the choir, rhythm section, and sound techs. We also took seven students to audition for the 2016 All State Jazz Choir. Of those seven, we had two students recalled and accepted-- Jonathan Norris as a tenor, and Madalyn Walker as an alto. They will perform with this prestigious group in July at the Iowa Choral Director's Convention in Pella with world renowned director Duane Davis. Congrats to all who auditioned and prepared for this process.
